Approval of Minutes - Leslie Sigler motioned to approve the minutes from February 13th. Ashley Young seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

Community Center Update – The Community Center is ready for electric to be installed and that will begin on Thursday, March 7th. The new televisions have also been installed for bingo and the bathroom has been fixed.

Police Update - There were 35 police officers at the evidence class held at the Community Center last week.

Street Update - The street department has been working at the Community Center getting it ready for BINGO.

NEW BUSINESS

Bases for Baseball Field - Mayor Young was informed that Kanawha Central Little League has already purchased new bases, so that is off the table.

Kanawha Central Little League - Regarding the batting cages, a complaint was made about a member of KCLL denying someone access to the batting cages. Mayor Young stated that the batting cages are property of the Town of Cedar Grove and are intended to be open to the public when they are not being used for official KCLL practices and/or games. Ryan Coleman expressed his concern for opening the cages up to the public as the KCLL helps to maintain them and wants to prevent them from being vandalized. As a solution, the council agreed to work on a plan to keep a key at the Town Hall for the public to come and retrieve so that they are able to keep track of who is using it and keep it safe.

Pump Repair - A pump needs to be replaced at one of the pump stations. Due to the expense of the new pump, the council opted to simply repair the existing pump. Mark Harrison motioned to repair the existing pump. Ryan Coleman seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.
